Exhibitor Guidelines and Information

Why Become a Green Day Vendor or Exhibitor?

- 1) Gain visibility and participate in an established event
- 2) Share your products and/or services with hundreds of attendees
- 3) Connect with other successful businesses or organizations
- 4) Educate our community and empower them to be more sustainable
- 5) Support Davidson Lands Conservancy and help protect land

- **Weather:** The festival will be held rain or shine. No Rain date is scheduled.
- Festival hours are 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m., Saturday, Sept. 15. Festival will be held on the Davidson Village Green, Main Street at Concord Road, Davidson, NC.
- **Applications:** Each applicant will be notified before Aug. 22 of their acceptance or rejection after the Davidson Green Day committee has reviewed the application.
- Fees are due at time of application.
- Instructions on parking, loading and unloading, and space assignments will be sent to exhibitors by Sept. 1.
- By signing and submitting the application, the exhibitor agrees to the conditions listed in the guidelines.
- Proceeds from Davidson Green Day / Run for Green will benefit the Davidson Lands Conservancy. Thank you for helping conserve lands for the future!
- **Booths:** Exhibitors are required to bring their own tent, tables, and chairs for their 10x10 space.
- Exhibitors must keep their booths open and staffed throughout the duration of the festival.
- Exhibitors shall not sublet their space to anyone.
- The use of generators at the festival is not allowed. Power sources are extremely limited; availability can't be guaranteed until booth assignments are made.
- **Sales and Use Tax:** Exhibitors acknowledge that they are solely responsible for sales and use tax and any types of permits, licenses or insurance they may need to acquire or provide.
- **Refund policy:** No refund will be given for any cancellations after September 7.
- Security will be provided at the site; however, the organizers accept no responsibility for items lost due to theft or breakage.
- Festival organizers make no representation or guarantees towards actual attendance.
- **Clean-up and Litter:** Exhibitors are responsible for disposing of their trash in appropriate trash and recycling bins. Please help us to "leave no trace."
- Help us to limit the amount of trash produced and left at the site. Limit the number of flyers, "giveaway items," and do not distribute Styrofoam, non-recyclable plastic, or balloons.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to sell or give away bottled water at the event.
