The **13th annual** Run for Green will be held Saturday September 15th here in Davidson! We will again have 1/2 Marathon, 10K, and 5k races, with proceeds to support DLC and land conservation in the Davidson community. We have lots going on Race Day: a band on the Green during and after the Race, friends from the Renaissance Festival joining us, and beer for runners after the Race (with proper ID), so join us and make a day of it in Davidson!

WOW Nature Outing: Butterflies, Bees, Bugs and Dragonflies

Sunday, August 19 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., in Davidson

We had a great time with Rob Van Epps last year on this outing, we've asked him to do it again! We hope you'll join us on a nature expedition with a local pollinator expert and naturalist, Rob Van Epps, Sunday, August 19. We'll be walking along local trails discovering butterflies, bees, bugs and dragonflies. August is peak time for butterflies in our area and, with some luck, we could see 20 or more different species. You'll have a chance to learn about butterfly life cycles, which kinds we should see in Davidson, and why they are so important. There are over 20,000 butterfly species in the world, and some of them live right here! In celebration of Davidson Lands Conservancy's publication of a butterfly book (see below for where to get it) and Davidson's being designated a Bee City (www.beecityusa.org), we're looking forward to master naturalist, Rob Van Epps, leading us on a nature walk.

This outing is for children with their families. **The minimum age is 4 years old.** No strollers nor dogs please. Registration closes Saturday, August 18, at 5pm.
